## A History of "Will Your Anchor Hold"

The Founder of The Boys' Brigade, Sir William Alexander Smith chose a good emblem and a good motto.
'Will your anchor hold in the storms of life, when the clouds unfold their wings of strife?
When the strong tides ift, and the cables stra in, will your anchor dnft or firm remain? We have an anchor that keeps the soul, Stedfast and Sure while the billows roll,


Fastened to the rock which cannot move, grounded firm and deep in the Saviour's lovel"
This rousing hymn by Priscilla Owens (1829-1899) is the official hymn of The Boys' Brigade. Priscilla Owen was born in Baltimore, but came from Scottish and Welsh descent. For more than fifty years she was active in Sunday School work in her home town, and most of her hymns and songs were written for Sunday school children.
Miss Owen was not the first to compare Christian faith to an anchor. In Chapter 6 Verse 19 of his Epistle to the Hebrews, St Paul wrote "We have this hope as an anchor for our lives, it is safe and sure through the curtain of the heavenly temple into the inner sanctuary
As the verses of the hymn unfold, they pass through the storms of life, and finally into the promise of a new dawn for followers of Jesus - our anchor.

The tune to which the hymn is sung, Will Your Anchor Hoid? was written by William J. Kirkpatrick (1838-1921).A carpenter from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, he became much involved in church work and composed many Gospel songs. Atogether he compiled eighty seven books of such songs, the sales of which ran into millions. He is best remembered for his tune 'Cradle Song' which is universally used for the Christmas carol 'Away in a Manger'.
